RE: AWARD BID FOR THE THERMALITO FAMILY CENTER AT NELSON POOL

SUMMARY

Four bids were received for the project on November 19th, 2020. The lowest bid was \$1,047,600 by Holiday Pools Construction of Chico. The current budget for the project is \$1,100,000. This includes \$750,000 from a Supplemental Benefit Fund (SBF) grant and \$350,000 in FRRPD Impact Fees. Total projected expenses for the project are shown below.

\$1,047,600.00	Holiday Pool Bid for Construction

It is estimated that the award of the Holiday Pool bid for construction will currently put the project \$86,054.80 over budget. As noted in previous staff reports, the project is estimated to be over budget due to the rising cost of construction since the initial SBF grant application was written in 2018.

One option to keep the project within budget is to remove some items from the project. This could include the shade structure and the grading and drainage of the grass area to the east of the pool deck. FRRPD staff is meeting with Holiday Pools on Monday 11/30/2020 to discuss this and other ways to lower the cost of construction. FRRPD may consider using more Impact Fees to make up the difference.

We have also notified the SBF Committee of the increased costs and plan to request additional funds for the grant. One problem with the SBF grant in the current budget is the lack of funding for the following grant items. The water slide, floating play equipment, bleachers and a new fence are not in the existing base bid. As noted above, the shade structure, grading and landscape of the grass area may need to be removed from the project. These are also SBF grant items.

RECOMMENDATION

Award the construction contract of the Thermalito Family Center at Nelson Pool project to Holiday Pools for the lowest bid amount of \$1,047,600. The next lowest bid was \$1,284,800 and the highest bid was \$1,544,000. Costs will continue to increase if the project is put on hold or out to bid at a later date.



Award of the bid now is necessary to keep the project on schedule to be ready for the 2021 swim season. FRRPD staff will work with Holiday Pools, FRRPD Impact Fees and the SBF Committee to keep the project within budget.
