

Pat Alley Memorial DOG PARK RULES

By entering this dog park you agree to assume all duties and releases of liability as follow:

You are legally responsible for any injuries or damage caused by your dogs. Users of these facilities do so at their own risk and agree to these rules.

Dogs shall be removed at the first sign of aggression. Dogs with known history of dangerous or aggressive behavior are prohibited. "Aggressive" is defined as a dog posing a threat to other animals or to human beings.

Owners (handlers) are responsible for the immediate bagging, removal and proper disposal of dog waste from the park using trash receptacles.

Dogs must be licensed, current on vaccinations and wearing ID at all times.

Dogs must be 6 mo. of age.

No dog in heat is permitted.

No animals other than dogs are permitted in this area.

Dogs are limited to two per handler.

You must remain with your dog who must be in sight and under voice control.

You must fill holes dug by your dog before leaving the park.

You must remain with your dog at all times. You may not "drop-off" a dog to play.

No food (dog or human) or glass containers are permitted in this area.

Please control excess barking.

Professional dog trainers may not use this facility to conduct their business unless sponsored by the FRRPD.

Dog grooming is prohibited in the park unless it is sponsored by FRRPD.

Dogs must be leashed when entering and leaving the park. Choke, pinch, shock and pronged collars must be removed with the leash.

Children must be 12 years of age or older to be in the park unless at an FRRPD sponsored event. Children must be supervised by their parents at all times.

Smoking, drugs, alcoholic beverages, and food are prohibited in the park.

No bicycles, skates, strollers or motorized vehicles are permitted.
