



PARK RULES

1. The consumption and/or possession of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in all Feather River Recreation and Park District facilities and parks, except for functions approved by the District with a written permit.
2. Smoking is not allowed in pavilions, buildings, restrooms, or within 25 feet of pavilions, buildings, and restrooms. Smoking is not allowed in or within 25 feet of any playground, play feature, or where children are gathered.
3. Dogs must be leashed at all times while in the park, except in the designated dog park.
4. Owners/handlers of dogs must clean up after their pets.
5. All users of parks and facilities are responsible for disposing of their trash after using the parks, facilities, buildings, or pavilions. Leave the area cleaner than how you found it.
6. No person shall engage in any game, activity, or conduct that causes, or is likely to cause, injury or damage to any tree, shrub, ornamental plant, building, or equipment.
7. No person shall unlawfully fight.
8. No person shall maliciously and/or willfully disturb another person by loud or unreasonable noise.
9. No person shall use offensive words or gestures.
10. No person shall engage in, or solicit anyone to engage in, lewd, dissolute, lascivious, or unlawful conduct within any of the facilities or parks owned or operated by the District.
11. No person shall accost another person, beg, or solicit without permission of the District.
12. No person shall loiter, remain, or sleep in any park or facility during such hours that the facility is deemed closed.
13. No person shall be under the influence of alcohol or any substance as defined by California Penal Code Section 647f and the Health and Safety Code.

14. No person shall interfere with, obstruct, or prevent the use of any park or facility.
15. No person shall throw or propel, in any way, an object in a willful and malicious manner that causes, or could cause, injury to another.
16. No person shall have in his possession a firearm or other device which is capable of being used as a weapon.
17. No person shall fail to cooperate in maintaining restrooms, dressing rooms, and washrooms in a neat and sanitary condition. Further, no person shall loiter in or about, nor use any park or facility for purposes other than those intended.
18. When using District facilities or participating in District programs where a prescribed fee exists, no person shall participate prior to paying the prescribed fee, unless otherwise authorized by the District.
