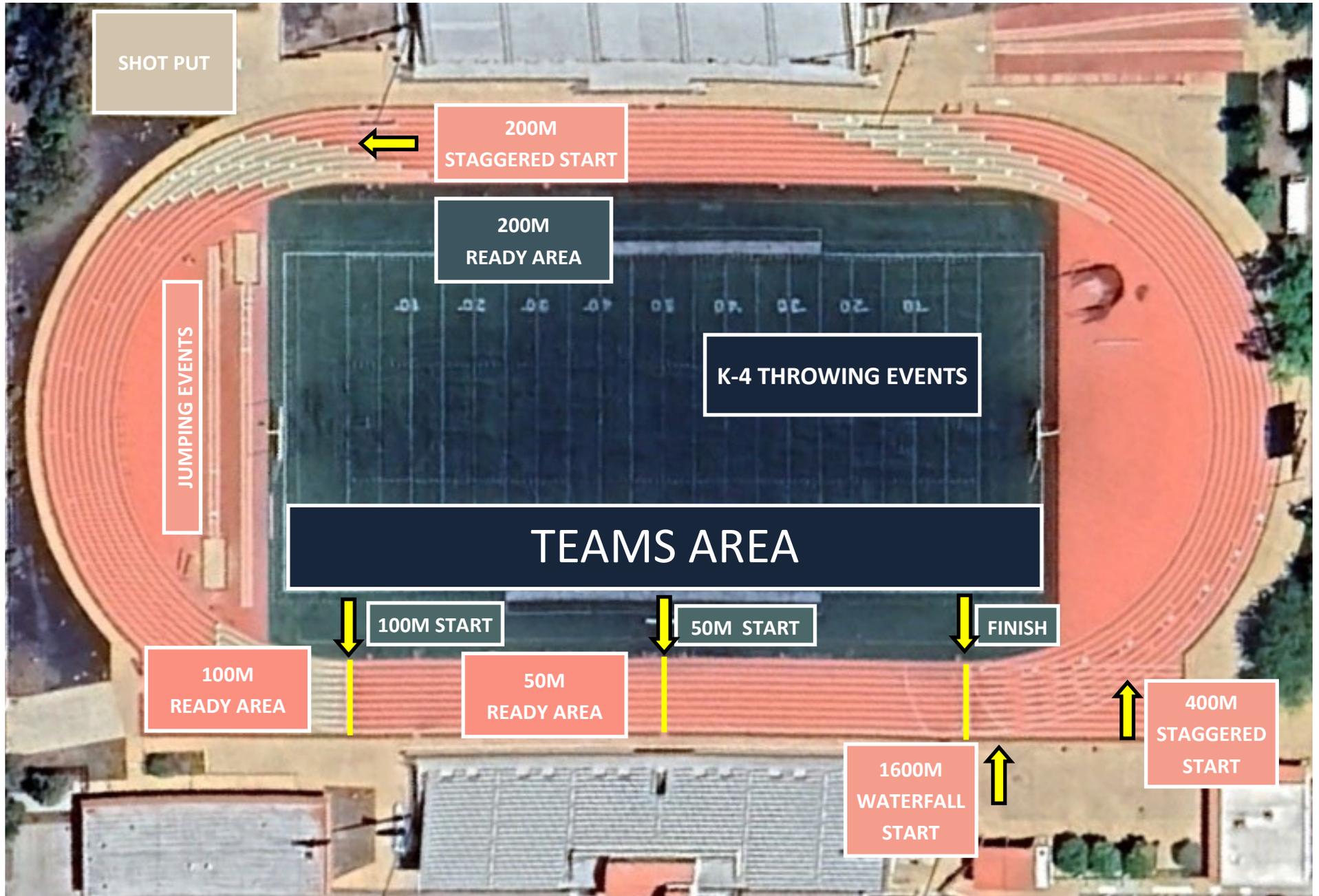


FRRPD YOUTH TRACK AND FIELD PROGRAM 2026

GENERAL NOTES:

- Team Area – Athletes/Coaches Only
- Event Area – Athletes/Coaches/Volunteers
- Spectators – Must remain in bleachers. Family not permitted on the track/field
 - Exception: Younger athletes that may need support getting to events.

RULES specific to turf/track areas

- No Food – No Gum – No Candy – No seeds
- Drinks – ONLY WATER – No exceptions
- No metal spikes or anchors.
- No track spikes of more than 1/8". NO NEEDLE SPIKES
- No animals/pets.

Running Events

- 50M Start from middle of straight away - Stay in assigned lane
- 100M Start from the marked starting area Stay in assigned lane
- 200M Staggered start in turn 3 Stay in assigned lane
- 400M Staggered start in turn 1 Stay in assigned lane
- 1600M Waterfall start at entrance of turn 1
 - May collapse coming out of turn 2?
 - Athlete should be prepared to provide a timer
- 4x100 Staggered start Stay in assigned lanes
 - Exchange zones – Runners need to be in correct lanes

Throwing Events

Softball Throw – 2 throwing lanes. 3 attempts per athlete. All throws will be marked.

Longest throw (where the ball first hits the ground) will be measured/recorded

Shot Put – Concerns about athlete safety/injuries due to incorrect form. 3 attempts per athlete. All throws will be marked. Longest throw will be measured/recorded.

Jumping Events

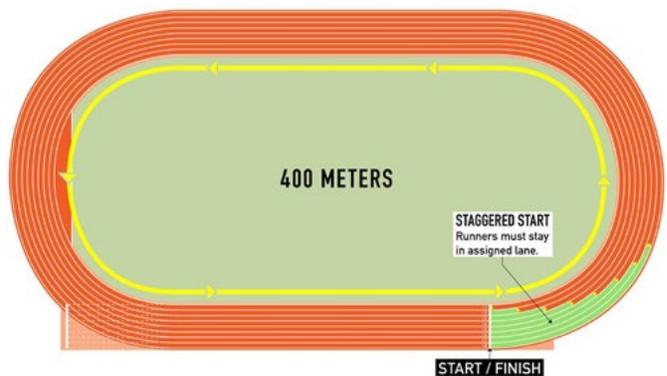
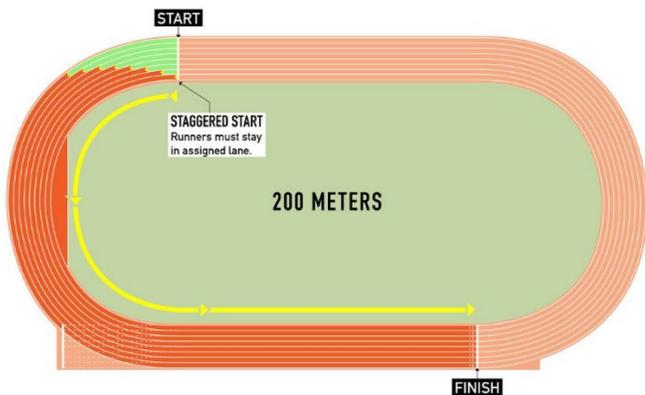
- K-4 Two Long Jump Lanes
- 5-8 1 long jump lane / 1 triple jump lane

3 attempts per athlete. In an attempt to keep things moving, athletes should not expect to get consecutive attempts if other athletes are waiting. All attempts will be marked, measured and recorded.

TRACK EVENTS

50M/100M/200M/400M

- Starter-FRRPD Staff
 - Confirm with head timer that finish area is clear and timers are ready
 - Walkie-Talkie / Flag
 - Call heat runners in to place
 - Staggered start positions for 200M / 400M
 - Raise starting device over head
 - Command “ON YOUR MARKS / SET ”
 - Fire the starting device (air-horn)
- Head Timer / Finish Judge -FRRPD Staff
 - Confirm with timers:
 - Lane assignment
 - Watch function start/stop/reset
 - Results recorded
 - Confirm to starter finish line is clear and timers are ready
 - Walkie-Talkie / Flag
 - Back up watches
- Lane Timer-Volunteer(s)
 - Confirm with head timer:
 - Lane assignment
 - Watch function
 - Watch malfunction
 - Raised hand – Head timer will provide replacement watch
 - Record results

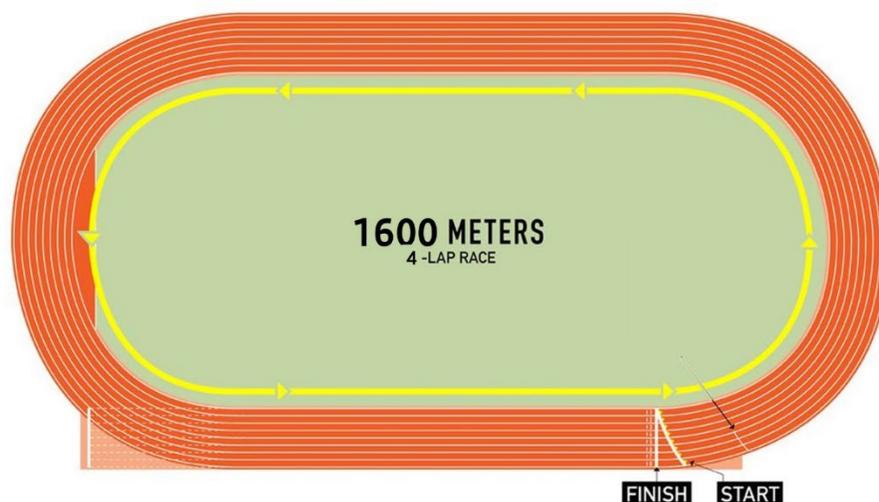

 - Fire the starting device (air-horn)
- Head Timer / Finish Judge-FRRPD Staff
 - Confirm with timers:
 - Runner assignment
 - Watch function start/stop/reset
 - Results recorded
 - Back up watches
 - Confirm runner lap count during race(s)
- Lane Timer-Volunteer(s)
 - Confirm with head timer:
 - Runner bib #
 - Watch function
 - Watch malfunction
 - Raised hand – Head timer will provide replacement watch
 - Record results

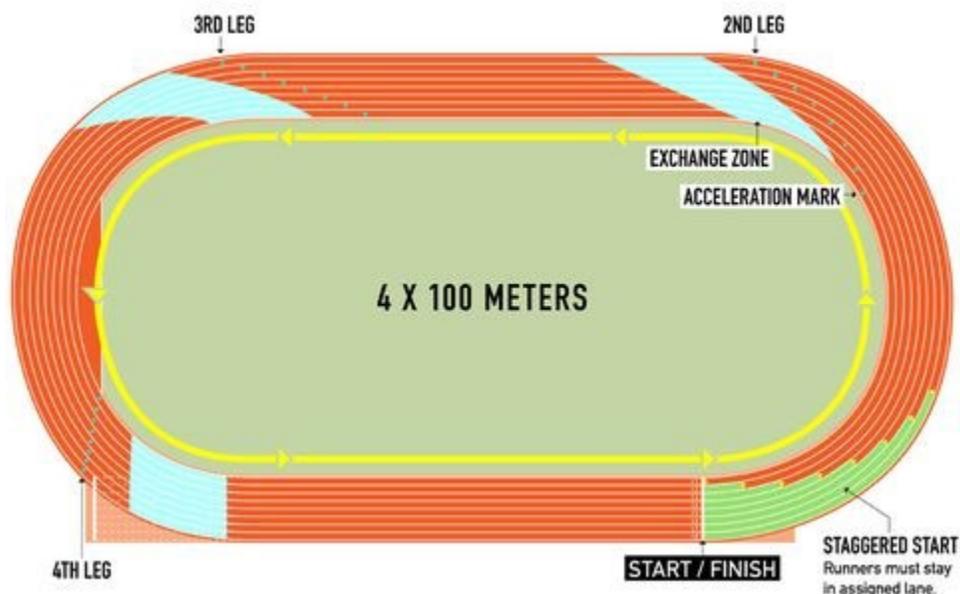

 - Command “ON YOUR MARKS”
 - Fire the starting device (air-horn)

 - Confirm with timers:
 - Lane Assignment
 - Watch function start/stop/reset
 - Results recorded
 - Back up watches
 - Confirm runners are in exchange areas
- Lane Timer-Volunteer(s)
 - Confirm with head timer:
 - Lane assignment
 - Watch function
 - Watch malfunction
 - Raised hand – Head timer will provide replacement watch
 - Record results
- Exchange area volunteers
 - Confirm runners for all teams are in exchange areas

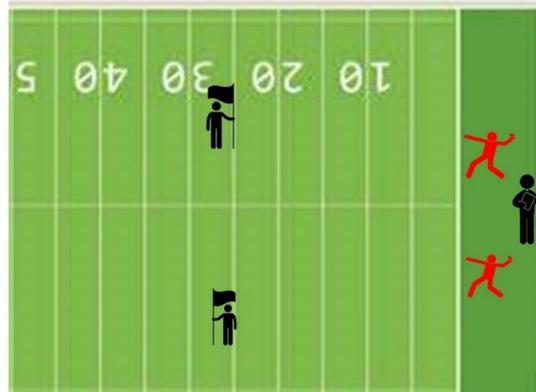

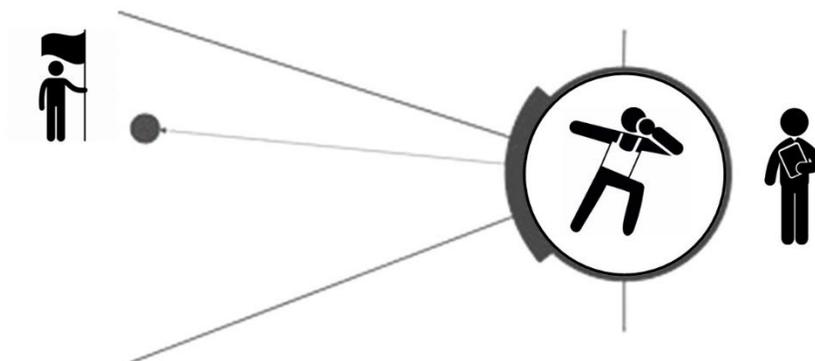
Softball Throw / Shot Put

 - Measure longest throw / Report distance to recorder



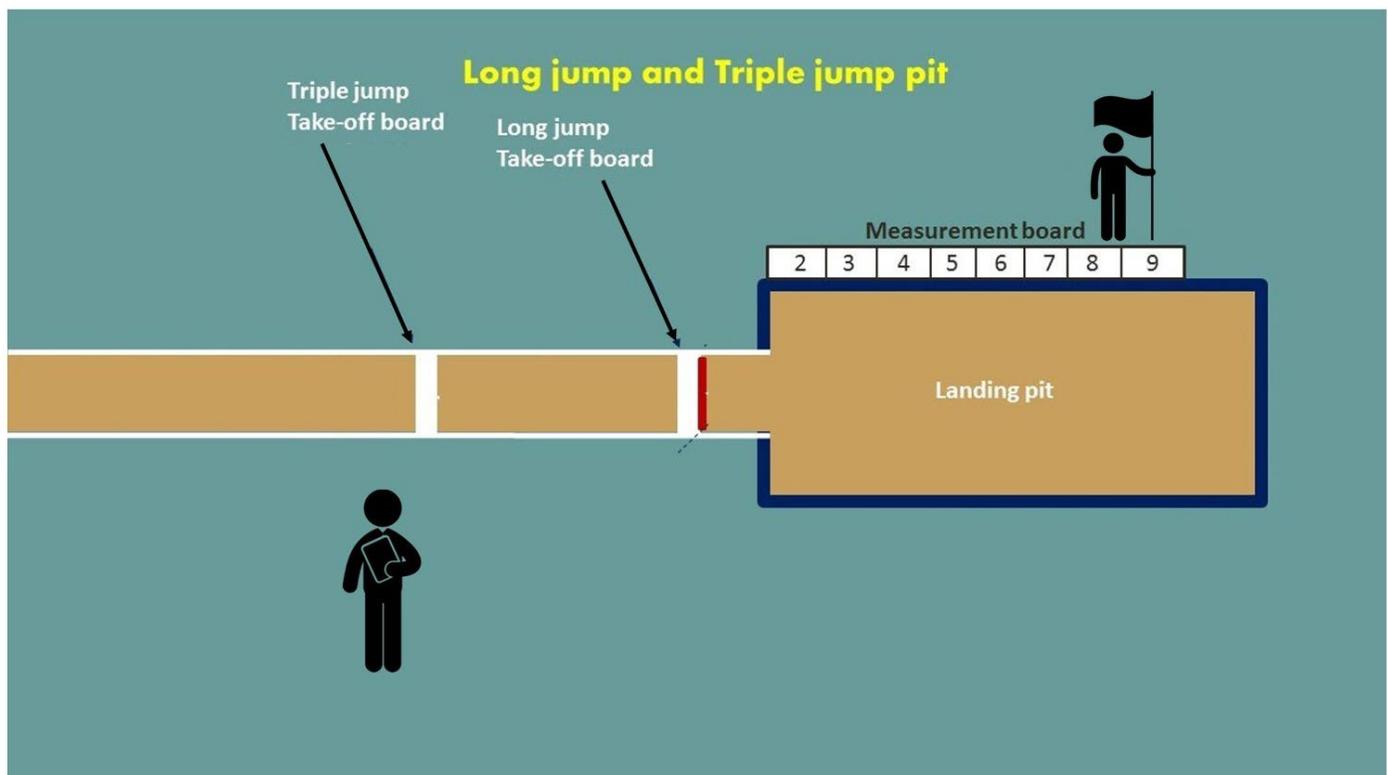
FIELD EVENTS – Jumping

 - Mark jump
 - Place flag at location outside of pit at where athlete contacted pit
 - Measure distance
 - Report distance to recorder

Triple Jump

- Results Recorder - Volunteer
 - Record athlete bib #
 - Record distances of 3 jumps
- Mark & Measure - Volunteers (2)
 - Mark jump
 - Place flag at location outside of pit at where athlete contacted pit
 - Measure distance
 - Report distance to recorder
 - Rake pit
