## *Hometown Christmas 2021 Vendor Guidelines*

The Yuba Feather Museum, town and artifacts are held in trust, and we are responsible for maintaining their quality and condition. Please respect the fully-furnished town buildings, on view We expect all vendors and participants in Hometown Christmas to adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Use decorations appropriate for a Gold Rush town.
2. Your display area is limited to your 10 x 10 space. Do not put signs, displays, lights, or merchandise on Museum buildings or property.
3. Electrical power is not available. Use battery powered lights only.
4. NO fire allowed (candles, lanterns, stoves, etc.), except for Museum's warming barrels.
5. Set up will begin at 8:00 a.m. All set up must be completed and all vehicles must be out of the Old Town by 10:00 a.m.
6. Each vendor is responsible for cleaning up all debris from their area at the end of the event.
7. All vendors must be approved by the Event Coordinator and Museum Committee.
8. If public safety would be compromised by excessive snow, ice, impassable roads, or Covid restrictions, we may be forced to cancel the event or close early. Vendor booth fee is not refundable.

Thank you for your cooperation in making this event enjoyable and safe.

**Resale Permits:** Yuba Feather Historical Association is required to provide a list of our vendors' names, phone numbers and resale permit numbers to the California State Board of Equalization (BOE). As with all retail sales, you are required to collect and remit proper sales tax to the BOE. If you are selling food items, please check with the BOE to see if you need to charge sales tax.

If you have applied for a resale permit but have not received it by November 27, you may sell at Hometown Christmas if you provide a copy of your application.
