Proposal Evaluation Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Demonstrated experience in similar engineering projects.
- Qualifications and experience of the project team.
- Proposed approach and methodology.
- Project timeline.
- Cost estimate, including all relevant expenses.

Proposal Requirements:

Interested engineering firms are requested to submit the following information:

1. Company Overview:

a. Provide a brief overview of your firm, including experience with similar projects.

2. Project Team:

a. Identify key personnel who will be dedicated to this project and their relevant experience.

3. References:

a. Provide at least three references from clients for whom you have provided similar engineering services.

4. Approach and Methodology:

a. Describe your proposed approach and methodology for the site assessment,



design, and construction oversight.

5. Budget Proposal:

- a. Present a detailed budget proposal outlining all costs associated with the project.
- 6. Timeline:
 - a. Provide a detailed project timeline, including key milestones and deadlines.
- 7. Insurance and Licensing:
 - a. Provide proof of insurance and licensing as required by local regulations.

Selection Process

FRRPD will review all submitted proposals and may conduct interviews or site visits with selected contractors. The final selection will be based on the evaluation criteria mentioned.

- Reject any or all proposals.
